It is proposed to fill 11 vacancies of Registrar/Secretary in the Pay Band 3 of Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs.7600/- (pre-revised) in Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunals (DRATs) and Debts Recovery Tribunals (DRT) on promotion/deputation basis, 23 vacancies of Recovery Officer in the Pay Band 3 of Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6600/- (pre-revised) in Debts Recovery Tribunal on promotion/deputation and 10 vacancies of Assistant Registrar in the Pay Band- 3 of Rs. 15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6600/- (pre-revised) in Debts Recovery Tribunals (DRTs) on deputation basis.

Eligible and interested officers may submit their applications, dully filled in the prescribed proforma **through proper channel only** (i.e. their Cadre Controlling Authority along with dully filled in Part-II of the application form and attested/certified copies of Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs)/Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs)/Grading for the last five years i.e. from 2012-13 to 2016-17. In case, ACR/APAR/Grading for a period of more than 3 months is not recorded, then ACR/APAR/Grading prior to 2011-12 for the matching period may be forwarded along with No Report Certificate (NRC) for such period (s) so as to reach the undersigned on or before 27th July, 2017. Advance copies of the applications or those received after last date or without requisite document shall be summarily rejected.

Desirable qualification:

Preference will be given to persons having legal experience or experience in judicial or recovery matters.

3. Age:

The maximum age limit for deputation shall be 56 years as on the last date of receipt of applications.

4. Cooling Off:

The candidature must fulfill a 'cooling off' period of 3 years from the date of his return from previous deputation.

5. The selected Departmental candidates will be appointed on promotion and outsiders will be appointed on deputation basis for a period of three years, which may be curtailed or extended in the interest of administrative exigencies. The pay and other terms and conditions of deputation will be governed by the Department of Personnel and Training Office Memorandum No. 6/8/2010-Estt. (Pay.II) dated 17.06.2010 as amended from time to time.

6. A separate application is to be submitted for each post by the candidates who apply for more than one post.

7. No application will be permitted to withdraw his/her candidature after selection. Doing so will attract blacklisting of such candidates for future deputation in DRTs/DRATs.

8. The Department reserves the right to relax the conditions in the interest of administrative exigencies for any or category of persons applying for any of the aforesaid posts.
