1. Introduction

The *Innovison* hackathon, successfully organized by Indian Bank in collaboration with IIT Madras is the second such hackathon of the PSBs Hackathon Series 2025. PSBs Hackathon Series 2025 is an initiative of the Department of Financial Services (DFS), Ministry of Finance, Government of India and supported by the Indian Banks Association (IBA).

2. Objective of PSBs Hackathon Series 2025

- ➤ To foster innovation in FinTech and Cybersecurity by bringing together students and banking professionals.
- ➤ To Encourage innovation and prototype development for the problem statements within the banking sector.
- > To Promote the use of technology and digital tools to improve banking services.
- ➤ To Provide opportunities for entrepreneurship by identifying commercially viable solutions.

3. Organization and Collaboration

Indian Bank associated with IIT Madras, one of the best institutes in the country, for organizing the Innovision hackathon.

4. Innovison Hackathon Theme & Problem Statement details

5. Innovision Hackathon Response & shortlisting of participating teams

22 numbers of ideas were submitted in the Fintech domain & 11 numbers of ideas were submitted in the Cyber Security domain. Out of which, 12 number of proposals under Fintech & 9 numbers of proposals under Cybersecurity domains were shortlisted.

Subsequently, each shortlisted team was assigned with a mentor nominated from Indian Bank/ IIT Madras to guide the participants for developing the prototypes.

6. Winners identified through evaluation of shortlisted prototypes by Jury

Jury comprising of experts from the FinTech and Cybersecurity domains (From RBI, NPCI, Indian Bank, IIT Madras, Kyndryl and eVaan) evaluated the Final Presentation & Prototypes developed by the shortlisted teams on 21st April 2025 at IIT Madras Campus.

- 2. Innovation and Originality (30%)
- 3. Feasibility and Scalability (20%)
- 4. Compliance and Ethical Considerations (20%)
