## NOTIFICATION

- G.S.R....- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Recovery of Debts Due to Banks and Financial Institutions Act, 1993 (51 of 1993), and in supersession of the Debts Recovery Tribunal (<u>location</u>), (Group 'C' and 'D' posts)(Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, (<u>year</u>) relating to the post of Lower Division Clerk, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Lower Division Clerk in Debts Recovery Tribunal, (<u>location</u>), namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Debts Recovery Tribunal, (<u>location</u>) (Lower Division Clerk) Recruitment Rules, 2016.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification, level in the pay matrix .- The number of post, its classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters related thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualifications.- No person -
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person; shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen, persons with disabilities and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
