NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 1st July, 2022.

S.O. ____(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1970 (5 of 1970), the Central Government, after consultation with the Reserve Bank of India, hereby makes the following Scheme further to amend the Nationalised Banks (Management and Miscellaneous Provisions) Scheme, 1970, namely:—

1. (1) This Scheme may be called the Nationalised Banks (Management and Miscellaneous Provisions) Amendment Scheme, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Nationalised Banks (Management and Miscellaneous Provisions) Scheme, 1970,—

- (i) in paragraph 2, clause (ba) shall be omitted;
- (ii) in paragraph 5, in sub-paragraph (1), the words, figure and letter “in the manner as specified in clause 7B” shall be omitted;
- (iii) in paragraph 6, sub-paragraph (2) shall be omitted;
- (iv) paragraphs 7A, 7B and 7C shall be omitted.
