## VACANCY CIRCULAR

The Debts Recovery Tribunal, Hyderabad is a quasi-judicial body set up under the provisions of the Recovery of Debts Due to Banks and Financial Institutions Act, 1993 by the Ministry of Finance, Department of Financial Services, Government of India.

2. It is proposed to fill-up the following vacant posts in this Tribunal on deputation basis from amongst regular employees of Central/ State Government/Courts/Tribunals, fulfilling the eligibility criteria mentioned hereunder:

- 3. The tenure of deputation shall be for a period of one year initially extendable up to three years. The period of deputation including period of deputation in excadre post held immediately preceding the appointment in the same or any other Organization/Department of Central Government, should ordinarily not exceed three years. The terms and conditions of deputation shall be governed by the provisions of DOPT's OM No. 2/29/91-Est (Pay –II) dated 05.01.1994 amended from time to time.
