

In partial modifications of this Ministry (Banking Division's) letter No. 3-16/2000-SCT(B) dated 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2001, I am directed to say that the Government of India has approved the upward revision of the rate of Conveyance Allowances for disabled employees ( Blind and Orthopaedically Handicapped Employees) in the Public Sector Banks/ Financial Institutions) from Rs. 200/- to Rs. 400/- per month in addition to the regular transport allowance of Rs. 105/- being paid to all award staff, payable uniformly at all places.

The above orders will be effective from immediate effect.
