Subject: - Appointment of Chief Vigilance Officer in National Housing Bank.

Sir,

The post of Chief Vigilance Officer in National Housing Bank is falling vacant on 14-12-2013. You are requested to ascertain the officers of the rank of General Manager or Deputy General Manager, having three years experience in the grade of DGM, desirous of being considered for appointment as CVO, National Housing Bank and forward the names of such officers along with their complete Bio-data in the format enclosed (under signatures of CVO of the bank) and their attested Annual Confidential Reports for the last five years (complete) in all respects including vigilance clearance to this Department on or before 24th May, 2013. It may be ensured that names of only those candidates whose services can be spared and who have minimum of 3 years of service remaining as on 15-12-2013 and are clear from vigilance angle are forwarded. The following case will not be considered:

- (i) The officers against whom some or the other penalty had been imposed in the past.
 - (ii) The officers having less than three years of service as on 15-12-2013.
2. The names of candidates once forwarded will not be permitted to be withdrawn in any circumstances. Therefore, while forwarding the names of candidate for CVO in the Nation Housing Bank, an undertaking may be obtained from the applicants to the effect that under no circumstances, they would withdraw their candidature once a decision is taken to nominate them as CVO in National Housing Bank and a copy thereof may also be furnished to this Department.

Whether right from the date of entry into service and in the entire career of the officer of any vigilance case or departmental proceedings or criminal cases were instituted and if so complete information indicating inter-alia the details of charges in those cases, and final conclusion, penalty imposed, if any, and whether exonerated of the charges may be indicated. In case, where an officer is exonerated in any departmental proceedings or court cases the detail should also be furnished in case the executive has gone on deputation or otherwise for a position in another organization during any period of his career, the information should be furnished after consulting the concerned organization.
